*Hat*

## Gauge

3.5 stitches to the inch on  
US size 8 needles.

## Finished size

Adult size hat has a  
circumference of 20 in.

## Instructions


On US size 8 circular (or DPN)  
needles, cast on 72 stitches.

Knit 5 rows of K2 P2 rib.

Knit 5 rows of stockinette.

For the next 24 rows, follow  
colorwork chart.

Begin in lower right hand corner and follow chart right to left, bottom to top.



Begin decreases

Row 25: \*K5 K2tog, repeat from \* to end of row.

Row 26: \*K4 K2tog, repeat from \* to end of row.


Row 27: \*K3 K2tog, repeat from \* to end of row.

Row 28: \*K2 K2tog, repeat from \* to end of row.

Row 29: \*K1 K2tog, repeat from \* to end of row.

Row 29: \*K repeat from \* to end of row.

Finish your hat as shown  
in the illustrated steps.



hat is still on needles


2

thread 3ft. tail of yarn  
through all stitches  
on needles



4

thread yarn  
through needle and  
stitch through hat  
several times to lock in








5 stitch through top of hat as shown, leaving a small loop at the top.

6

Put crochet hook through loop and begin single crochet chain



7 single crochet 10 stitches



At the last crochet stitch, pull thread all the way through loop. Thread through needle and stitch through hat several times, tying off on the inside of the hat.
